ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Exemption from regulation 7 (1) of Cap. 43:11 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Investment, Trade and Industry by section 38 as read with section 42 (2) (g) of the Liquor Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor (Exemption) (No. 23) Regulations, 2017. Citation

2. ZCX Investments (Pty) Ltd, t/a Liquorama Bottle Store operating a bar in restaurant business at Mokgobelele Ward in Letlhakane is exempted from the provisions of regulation 7 (1) of the Liquor Regulations, which requires proposed business premises to be at least 500 metres away from a school, highway, major road or church. Exemption from regulation 7 (1) of Cap. 43:11 (Sub. Leg.)
