

## PROCLAMATION.

BY

HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

No. 14, 1907.—DATED 31st MAY, 1907.

### Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend so much of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899, defining the boundaries of the Native Reserves within the Bechuanaland Protectorate as purports to confer upon the Bakwena tribe the right to use certain waters outside the limits defined as a reserve for such tribe and within the limits defined as a reserve for the Bakhatla tribe;

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

### Repealing the last paragraph of Section 3 of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899.

1. The last paragraph of Section 3 of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899, shall be and is hereby repealed, and there shall be substituted therefor the following provision:—

“The water of the Kopong and Kopi Spruits shall be for the common use of the Bakhatla and Bakwena tribes for such distances along

the courses of such spruits as the same form a common boundary between the Bakhatla Native Reserve and the Bakwena Native Reserve as herein defined."

**Commencement of Proclamation.**

2. This Proclamation shall have force and effect from the date of its first publication in the *Gazette*, and shall be read as one with Proclamation No. 9 of 1899.
