

**PROCLAMATION.**

**Preamble.**

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Proclamation No. 15 of 1904 with reference to the right of appearance before courts of resident magistrate in the Bechuanaland Protectorate;

PROCLAMATIONS.

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

**Amending Section 7 of Proclamation No. 15 of 1904.**

1. Section *seven* of Proclamation No. 15 of 1904 shall be and is hereby amended by the insertion therein after the word "Proclamation", where it first occurs in the said section of the following words: "persons entitled to appear in courts of resident magistrate under the provisions of Rule 13 in Schedule B to Act No. 20 of 1856 of the Cape of Good Hope."

**Commencement of Proclamation.**

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
