

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 97 of 1922.

It is hereby notified for general information, in terms of section five of the High Commissioner's Proclamation No. 3 of 1922, to facilitate the reciprocal enforcement of judgments and awards in the United Kingdom and the Bechuanaland Protectorate that, whereas His Royal Highness the High Commissioner is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the legislatures of the territories named in the first column of the subjoined Schedule for the enforcement within such territories of judgments obtained in a Court of Assistant Commissioner or Magistrate in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, His Royal Highness has been pleased to declare that the said Proclamation shall extend to judgments obtained in a Court mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule within any of the territories named in the first column of the said Schedule in the like manner as it extends to judgments obtained in a superior court in the United Kingdom.
