PROCLAMATION

BY HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Further amending the Cattle Purchase for Export (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1911.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Cattle Purchase for Export (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1911 (No. 36 of 1911) as amended by Proclamations No. 48 of 1916 and No. 46 of 1919 (herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation");

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim, and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "twenty-five" in place of the word "fifty" before the words "pounds sterling."
2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
