

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending Proclamation No. 3 of 1922 which provides for facilitating the reciprocal enforcement of judgments and awards in the United Kingdom and the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the High Commissioner's Proclamation No. 3 of 1922 (herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation") which provides for facilitating the reciprocal enforcement of judgments and awards in the United Kingdom and the Bechuanaland Protectorate and enables like provisions to be extended to judgments obtained in a superior court in any part of His Majesty's Dominions outside the United Kingdom;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *five* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section:—

"(4) For the purpose of this section a Court in any part of His Majesty's Dominions outside the United Kingdom (as herein before defined) shall be deemed to be a superior court if the legislature of that part has for the purpose of any law facilitating the reciprocal enforcement of judgments and awards in other parts of His Majesty's Dominions outside the United Kingdom (as herein before defined) and that part named such Court as a Court in respect of which such reciprocal provision is to be made."

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
