PROCLAMATION

By His Royal Highness the High Commissioner

Entitled "The Bechuanaland Protectorate Marriage Amendment Proclamation, 1922."

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Marriage Proclamation, 1917 (which Proclamation as amended by Proclamation No. 14 of 1917 is herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation") so as to provide for the appointment as Marriage Officers of persons holding responsible positions in any religious denomination or community;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim, and make known as follows:—

1. Sections *seven* and *twelve* of the said Proclamation shall be, and are, hereby amended by the insertion after the words "any Minister of Religion," wherever they occur therein, of the following words "or person holding a responsible position in any religious denomination or community."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Marriage Amendment Proclamation, 1922, and shall be read as one with the said Proclamation, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
