PROCLAMATION

BY HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled "The Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties (Tobacco) Amendment Proclamation, 1922."

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties (Tobacco) Proclamation, 1921, as amended by the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1922 (herein after referred to as the "principal law"):

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (4) of section *four* of the principal law shall be and is hereby amended by the insertion therein after the words "under this Proclamation" of the words "or to any dealer licensed or manufacturer licensed under any Act dealing with excise or customs duty upon tobacco in the Union of South Africa, provided that such person shall, when called upon, produce an acknowledgment of receipt of the tobacco in the form prescribed by regulation or pay duty on such tobacco."

2. Paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section *eighteen* of the principal law shall be and is hereby repealed and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—

"(a) Exempting from or granting a rebate of the excise duty on tobacco manufactured in the territory when entered for removal to places outside the territory."

3. This Proclamation which may be cited for all purposes as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties (Tobacco) Amendment Proclamation, 1922, shall be read as one with the principal law, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
