It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *eleven* (2) of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, No. 33 of 1923, His Royal Highness the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that for the purposes of the said Proclamation the term "patent or proprietary medicines" shall not be deemed to include the undermentioned household remedies, whether sold under a particular trade mark or labelled with a recommendation or not, namely:—
