

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 70 of 1923.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *six* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1922 (No. 47 of 1922), His Royal Highness the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that there shall be charged, levied, collected, and paid on superphosphates containing not less than 17 per cent. of available phosphoric acid imported into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Holland a special Custom's duty equal to the difference between the price thereof as set forth in sub-section (i), added to the charges set forth in sub-section (ii) of section *six* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1922, and the amount at which such goods from Holland are being sold or offered for sale in the Bechuanaland Protectorate or in the Union.
