PROCLAMATION

By HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending the Official Secrets (Bechuanaland Protectorate)
Proclamation, 1922.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Official Secrets (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1922 (herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation") which amended the Official Secrets (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1914 (referred to in the said Proclamation as "the principal law"):

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *six* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "and" after the word "abets" and the insertion in place thereof of the word "or."

2. The First Schedule to the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the insertion of the word "military" after the word "naval" in the first amendment to section *three* of the principal law.

3. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and the principal law and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
