### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Further amending the Large Game Preservation Proclamation, 1904, of the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Large Game Preservation Proclamation, 1904, by providing for the temporary modification in particular portions of the Bechuanaland Protectorate of the definition of "large game" therein contained;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the Large Game Preservation Proclamation, 1904, shall be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso at the end thereof:—

" Provided however that it shall be lawful for the High Commissioner from time to time by notice in the *Gazette* to modify temporarily in respect of any specified portion of the Bechuanaland Protectorate the definition of 'large game' herein contained by excluding therefrom wildebeeste or any other animal, and the provisions of this Proclamation and of any Proclamation amending the same shall for the period specified in such notice cease in accordance therewith to apply in such portion to any animal excluded thereby."

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
