PROCLAMATION

By His Royal Highness the High Commissioner

Reducing the export duty payable upon horned cattle exported from the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is desirable to reduce the export duty payable upon horned cattle exported from the Bechuanaland Protectorate under the Bechuanaland Protectorate Cattle Export Duty Proclamation 1916 as amended by Proclamation No. 9 of 1920.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Cattle Export Duty Proclamation 1916 as amended by Proclamation No. 9 of 1920 shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "five shillings" and the reinsertion in place thereof of the words "two shillings and sixpence," and section *one* of Proclamation No. 9 of 1920 shall be and is hereby repealed.

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
