

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 20 of 1924.

Notice is hereby given, under the provisions of section *one* of Proclamation No. 2 of 1907, that it shall not be lawful during a period of one year from the first day of March, 1924, to kill, catch, capture, pursue, hunt, or shoot on the Crown land north of the Molopo River any large game as defined in section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Large Game Preservation Proclamation, 1904 (No. 22 of 1904), as amended by subsequent Proclamations.
