With reference to High Commissioner's Notice No. 104 of 1923, it is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *eleven* (2) of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, No. 33 of 1923, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that for the purposes of the said Proclamation the term "patent or proprietary medicines" shall not be deemed to include the undermentioned remedies, whether sold under a particular trade mark or labelled with a recommendation or not, namely—

Bacillogen glycogen pills.
Bacillogen preparations.
