

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 9 OF 1924.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon him by section *two* of the Fugitive Criminals Surrender Proclamation, 1908 (No. 14 of 1908), by which provision is made for the surrender of fugitive criminals in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to direct that as from the 1st day of February, 1924, the said Proclamation shall apply in the case of Belgium and the Belgian Congo under and in accordance with the Treaty which was concluded on the 29th day of October, 1901, between His late Majesty King Edward VII. and His late Majesty the King of the Belgians and the Supplementary Conventions of the 5th day of March, 1907, the 3rd day of March, 1911, and the 8th day of August, 1923.
