PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

To amend the Purchase of Stock (Bechuanaland Protectorate)
Proclamation, 1923.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Purchase of Stock (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1923 (No. 43 of 1923) herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:

1. Section *ten* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following subparagraph:—

"(e) The holder of a current butcher's licence issued in the territory may without obtaining a licence under this Proclamation purchase or acquire by barter or exchange live stock at his licensed premises, or elsewhere, for the purposes of his business, subject to the provisions of section *sixteen* of this Proclamation, and such holder shall not in any case be required to make any deposit or to find security under the provisions of section *six* of this Proclamation."

2. Section *sixteen* of the said Proclamation shall hereby be amended by the insertion of the words "butcher's licence" after the words "general dealer's licence."

3. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
