

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 101 of 1925.

It is hereby notified for general information, in terms of section *five* of the High Commissioner's Proclamation No. 3 of 1922 as amended by Proclamation No. 67 of 1922 to facilitate the reciprocal enforcement of judgments and awards in the United Kingdom and the Bechuanaland Protectorate that, whereas His Excellency the High Commissioner is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the legislature of Uganda for the enforcement within Uganda of judgments obtained in a Court of Assistant Commissioner or Magistrate in the Bechuaualand Protectorate, His Excellency has been pleased to declare that the said Proclamation as amended shall extend to judgments obtained in the High Court of Uganda in the like manner as it extends to judgments obtained in a superior court in the United Kingdom.
