

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 35 OF 1925.

REGISTRATION OF BRANDS IN THE BECHUANALAND  
PROTECTORATE.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of section *eighteen* of Proclamation No. 7 of 1907, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulation for the proper carrying out of the provisions of the Proclamation:—

“For the purposes of section *six* of Proclamation No. 7 of 1907 the registration is prohibited from the date hereof of any brand which, in the opinion of the Resident Commissioner, is identical with or similar to a brand which at the date of application is registered in the Union of South Africa.”
