

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 67 of 1925.

It is hereby notified for general information, in terms of section *five* of the High Commissioner's Proclamation No. 3 of 1922, as amended by Proclamation No. 67 of 1922, to facilitate the reciprocal enforcement of judgments and awards in the United Kingdom and the Bechuanaland Protectorate, that, whereas His Excellency the High Commissioner is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Legislature of New Zealand for the enforcement within New Zealand of judgments obtained in a Court of Assistant Commissioner or Magistrate in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, His Excellency has been pleased to declare that the said Proclamation, as amended, shall extend to judgments obtained in the Supreme Court of New Zealand in the like manner as it extends to judgments obtained in a superior court in the United Kingdom.
