PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Court Fees
Proclamation, 1925.

Whereas it is desirable to remove doubts as to the validity of a certain Rule of Court fixing the tariff of fees to be allowed on taxation in the Courts of the Bechuanaland Protectorate (herein after referred to as the territory) and to make further provision for the fixing of such fees in the Courts of the territory;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Proclamation No. 19 of 1898 or in any other law the tariff of fees approved by the High Commissioner and published under Government Notice No. 3 of 1924 shall be deemed and taken to have been validly made.

2. The Resident Commissioner may with the approval of the High Commissioner make and from time to time alter or withdraw Rules of Court prescribing the fees to be allowed on taxation in the Courts of the territory and such rules when approved as aforesaid shall be published in the *Gazette*.

3. Proclamation No. 19 of 1898 is hereby repealed.

4. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Court Fees Proclamation 1925 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
