

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 101 of 1926.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *sixty-one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Management Proclamation, 1914 (No. 84 of 1914), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulation:—

1. The Resident Magistrates respectively for the time being of the various districts of the Bechuanaland Protectorate as defined in High Commissioner's Notice No. 119 of 1923, and any notice amending that notice, shall, within their respective districts, be the proper officers of Customs for the purposes of carrying out any duties assigned to the proper officers of Customs under the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Management Proclamation, 1914, or any other law relating to Customs.
