

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 31 of 1926.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.—POSTAGE RATES.

It is hereby notified for general information that the rates of postage for the Bechuanaland Protectorate, as shown under Item No. 7 of High Commissioner's Notice No. 170 of 1925, are applicable only in the case of parcels posted in the Bechuanaland Protectorate to destinations within the Territory, but not including parcels which pass through other Administrations, viz.: parcels for Maun, Kasane, and Ghanzi, in respect of which the present rate of 1s. 3d. per lb. or part thereof continues to apply.

The rates of postage on letters, etc., as notified in the above-mentioned notice do not apply in the case of letters, etc., for transmission to the United Kingdom and elsewhere abroad.

No change has been made in the rates for parcels to destinations outside the Bechuanaland Protectorate.
