

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 36 of 1926.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN DUMPING DUTIES.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel the following notices:—

Notice No. 71 of 1923, in so far as it relates to the imposition of a dumping duty on wheat flour and wheat meal [paragraph (1)] and wheat [paragraph (2)] imported into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Australia; and Notice No. 99 of 1924, whereby a dumping duty was imposed on carbonate of soda imported into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Great Britain.
