PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Entitled the Customs Tariff (Amendment) Proclamation, 1926.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, of the Bechuanaland Protectorate (herein after referred to as "the territory"):

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section six of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925 (herein after referred to as the principal law), is hereby amended by the addition—

(a) to sub-section (1) at the end thereof of the following words:
"and imported into the territory therefrom"; and

(b) to sub-section (2) at the end thereof of the following words:
"Provided that any rebates in operation under this sub-section shall in like manner apply to similar goods grown, produced or manufactured in the United Kingdom and imported into the territory therefrom"; and

(c) of the following new sub-section (3):

"(3) In the event of one of the Dominions mentioned in sub-section (2) withdrawing the preferential tariff rates applicable at the commencement of this Proclamation to goods grown, produced or manufactured in the Union, that part of the Second Schedule to this Proclamation which applies to goods grown, produced or manufactured in the said Dominion shall cease to have force and effect as from the date of such withdrawal: Provided that such preferential rates shall continue to apply to goods shipped to the territory from any such Dominion prior to the date of such withdrawal."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Chapter II of the principal law, if the High Commissioner is satisfied that wheaten flour is being imported into the territory or into the Union at export prices free on board which are less than the domestic value thereof as defined by section *nineteen* of the principal law, and that the difference between such prices and such domestic value exceeds seven pence per one hundred pounds, the High Commissioner may by notice in the *Gazette* declare that a dumping duty shall be levied on such wheaten flour from a country or countries named in the notice; and from and after the date specified in such notice a dumping duty equal to the excess over such seven pence per one hundred pounds weight shall be levied on such flour on importation into the territory: Provided that—

(i) no dumping duty shall be imposed in respect of flour shipped to the territory from the country named in the notice prior to the date specified therein; and

(ii) such duty shall not exceed one-half of the value of the goods for duty purposes, as defined in section *fourteen* of the principal law.

3. The First and Second Schedules to the principal law are hereby amended to the extent shown in the First and Second Schedules respectively to this Proclamation.

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Amendment) Proclamation, 1926, and shall be read as one with the principal law, and shall have force and take effect—

- (a) as regards any duties which are hereby imposed or increased as from the thirty-first day of March, 1926;
 (b) in other respects as from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
