PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

To vest in the British South Africa Company certain land in the Bechuanaland Protectorate forming part of the Government Reserve at Selika and to provide for the registration of such land and certain other land in the name of the Company.

Whereas by Proclamation No. 13 of 1905 dated 30th June 1905 certain lands were vested in the British South Africa Company (herein after called the company);

And whereas these lands were granted in accordance with the provisions of the said Proclamation to the company under a title dated the 22nd February 1906;

And whereas certain other land within a radius of three miles of Selika (or Nwapa) with the exception of an area of approximately three thousand morgen as shown on a plan endorsed by the High Commissioner and by the company and filed in the Office of the Resident Commissioner at Mafeking, were by Proclamation No. 10 of 1914 vested in the company subject to the provisions and restrictions contained in Proclamation No. 13 of 1905;

And whereas it is desirable to relinquish a portion, in extent four hundred and forty-four morgen seven square roods, of the said three thousand morgen, and to vest it in the company;

And whereas it is also desirable to register in the name of the company—

- (1) the land at Selika vested in the company under Proclamation No. 10 of 1914;
- (2) the four hundred and forty-four morgen seven square roods above referred to;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. A portion, in extent four hundred and forty-four morgen seven square roods, of the land constituting the Government Reserve at Selika (or Nwapa) is hereby relinquished and vested in the British South Africa Company. The land thus relinquished is shown on a plan No. 820, 1922 filed in the Office of the Resident Commissioner at Mafeking.

2. The land vested under the preceding section and the land at Selika vested in the company under Proclamation No. 10 of 1914 shall henceforth be regarded as though they had been included in the land held by the company under the title-deed dated 22nd February 1906 and shall be subject to the provisions and reservations contained in sections *two* to *nine* inclusive of Proclamation No. 13 of 1905.

3. The Registrar of Deeds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate is hereby authorized to register in the name of the company the land vested in the company under section *one* and the land at Selika vested in the company under Proclamation No. 10 of 1914, and to endorse the original and floating copies of the title-deed dated the 22nd February 1906 in terms of section *two*.

4. The limits and boundaries of the Crown land reserved for Government purposes at Selika shall henceforth be in accordance with those represented on the diagram A 144.1926 filed in the Office of the Resident Commissioner at Mafeking.

5. The boundary lines of the company's land, known as the Tuli Block, where it abuts on the Crown land reserved for Government purposes at Selika shall, for the purposes of the title-deed of the 22nd February 1906, be regarded as being coincident with the boundaries of the reserve as indicated on the diagram referred to in section *four*.

6. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from a date to be fixed by the High Commissioner by notice in the *Gazette*.
