PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Amending further the Bechuanaland Protectorate Poll Tax Proclamation, 1922 (No. 44 of 1922).

Whereas it is desirable further to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Poll Tax Proclamation 1922 (No. 44 of 1922), herein after referred to as the principal law;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the principal law shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

(a) By the insertion at the beginning of the section of the figure (1).

(b) By the addition at the end thereof of a new sub-section as follows:—

(2) The Resident Commissioner may also exempt from the payment of poll tax for any year any person who shall satisfy him that he is indigent and is unable by reason of age to maintain himself.

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the principal law and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
