PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending in certain respects the Proclamation of the 10th of June, 1891, so as to authorize the endorsement of conditions on trading licences issued in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is desirable to amend in certain respects the Proclamation of the 10th of June, 1891 (herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation") so as to authorize the endorsement of conditions on trading licences issued in the Bechuanaland Protectorate:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *twenty-three* of the said Proclamation as amended by Proclamations Nos. 47 of 1916 and No. 14 of 1918 is hereby further amended by the addition of the following words at the end thereof:

"The Resident Commissioner shall cause to be endorsed thereon such conditions as he shall consider to be necessary and any condition so endorsed shall be deemed to be a condition of the licence for the purposes of section *thirty* of this Proclamation."

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
