

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 17 of 1927.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon him by section *two* of the Fugitive Criminals Surrender Proclamation, 1908 (No. 14 of 1908), by which provision is made for the surrender of fugitive criminals in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to direct that the said Proclamation shall apply in the case of the Czechoslovak Republic during the continuance of the arrangement made between His Majesty the King and the President of the Czechoslovak Republic, under which the Bechuanaland Protectorate is to surrender fugitive criminals to the Czechoslovak Republic.
