

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 24 OF 1927.

It is hereby notified for general information that the Secretary of State has been pleased to notify His Excellency the High Commissioner that His Majesty will not be advised to exercise his power of disallowance with respect to Proclamation No. 8 of 1927 making provision in the Bechuanaland Protectorate for the appointment of a Railway Commission and for the fixing of railway charges, the operation whereof was suspended until the signification of His Majesty's pleasure thereupon.

It is further notified that His Excellency has been pleased, under the provisions of section *thirty-four* of the Proclamation, to fix the eleventh day of March, 1927, as the date upon which the Proclamation shall come into operation.
