PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner

Amending Proclamation No. 20 of 1904 whereby provision was made as to the compensation of owners of stock killed or injured by trains running over lines of railways within the limits of the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is expedient to amend in certain respects Proclamation No. 20 of 1904 (herein after called "the said Proclamation") whereby provision was made as to the compensation of owners of stock killed or injured by trains running over lines of railways within the limits of the Bechuanaland Protectorate:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known as follows:—

1. The definition of "stock" in section *three* of the said Proclamation is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "or" after the word "bull" and the substitution therefor of the words "ox, heifer, tolly" and by the addition of the word "pig" after the word "goat" and before the word "and."

2. Section *four* of the said Proclamation is hereby amended by the addition of the words "For any pig, £1. 10s. 0d." after the last line.

3. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
