## PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending Proclamation No. 10 of 1914 relating to the grant of land in the Tuli Block, Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas by section *one* of Proclamation No. 10 of 1914 of the Bechuanaland Protectorate it was provided that a plan endorsed by the High Commissioner and by the British South Africa Company should be filed in the Office of the Resident Commissioner at Mafeking showing the lands dealt with under that section:

And whereas it appears that a plan has not been filed as provided by the said section:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The diagram numbered 820A, 1922 showing the lands excepted from the provisions of section *one* of Proclamation No. 10 of 1914 shall, when certified by the High Commissioner as showing the area referred to in that section be filed in the Office of the Resident Commissioner at Mafeking, and shall be deemed for all purposes to be the plan referred to in that section.

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
