PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Providing for the reduction in certain cases of the amount payable in respect of licences imposed on certain persons using or carrying guns in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is expedient to amend further the Proclamation of the 12th of December 1892 as amended by Proclamations Nos. 23 of 1914 and 44 of 1919 (herein after referred to as the said Proclamation) so as to reduce in certain cases the amount payable in respect of licences imposed on certain persons using or carrying guns in the Bechuanaland Protectorate:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby further amended by the addition of the following words at the end thereof: Provided that in the case of residents of the Bechuanaland Protectorate who have resided therein not less than twelve months immediately prior to the granting of such licence and of officials of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration the amount payable on such licence shall be ten shillings.

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the first day of January 1928 and shall be read as one with the said Proclamation.
