

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

MOTOR ROADS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section *fourteen*, sub-sections (1) and (3), of Proclamation No. 10 of 1929, I do prohibit the use of motor-cars which, with their loads, exceed 4,000 lb. in weight, upon those portions of the public roads herein after described, and do declare the said portions of roads to be motor roads, namely:—

LOBATSI-KANYE.

From the sign post bearing the notice "Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" at the gate in the Lobatsi-Kanye main wagon road five miles west of Lobatsi where the motor road branches to the north-west of the wagon road until the said motor road crosses the wagon road at Moswanen sixteen miles west of Lobatsi and continues on the south of the main wagon road until it again crosses the said wagon road at Lotlhakane Village at the sign post bearing the notice "Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road"; thence continuing on the north of the wagon road crossing the cement drifts at Morinyane and Mogapi; thence again due west across the main wagon road at Mogapi; thence west, south-west to Kanye Village.

GABERONES STATION-MOLEPOLOLE.

From the sign post bearing the notice "To Molepolole—Motors Only—Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" close to the gate at Mogoditsane in the fence forming the boundary between the farm Bonnington and the Bakwena Reserve, keeping to the specially constructed exclusive motor track to the sign post bearing the notice "Motors only—Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" at the intersection of the wagon roads half mile east by north of the Government Camp at Borakalalo (Molepolole) and from thence continuing by the motor road to the said Camp, a total distance of 31 miles from the Mogoditsane gate aforesaid.

FRANCISTOWN-BOSOLI.

From the sign post bearing the notice "Motor Road—Motor vehicles with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" at the junction of the wagon and motor roads, 2½ miles from Francistown, east of the railway line and just outside the railway strip, north as far as Bosili Siding at the sign post bearing the notice "Motor Road—Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road."

RAMAQUABANE SIDING-RHODESIAN BORDER.

From the sign post bearing the notice "Motor Road—Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" three miles south of Ramaquabane Siding where the road turns east through Malgre Tout farm to the sign post bearing the notice "Motor Road—Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" half a mile south of the Protectorate-Rhodesia border gate.

This notice to take effect from the 1st September, 1929.
