

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 110 OF 1929.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

ADDITIONAL CUSTOMS DUTY ON CERTAIN SUGARS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of section *three* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation No. 20 of 1925, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that Notice No. 116 of 1926 is amended by the deletion of the word "castor" and that from and after the fifth day of October, 1929, the suspended duty of three shillings and sixpence per 100 lb. is imposed on this class of sugar.
