

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 47 OF 1929.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section seven of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Public Service Proclamation (No. 32 of 1924) His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the Public Service Regulations published under Notice No. 145 of 1925, as follows:—

In Chapter I—General, Paragraph 1, for the words “Regulations for His Majesty's Colonial Service” substitute “Regulations for His Majesty's Colonial Services.”

In Chapter II—Discipline, for words “Section 5, Chapter II of the Colonial Regulations” substitute “Chapter II B. of the Colonial Regulations” and for “regulation No. 56” substitute “regulation No. 42.”
