

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 51 OF 1929.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

**WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN EXCHANGE DUMPING
DUTIES.**

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel the following notices:—

Notice No. 40 of 1925, whereby exchange dumping duties were imposed on asbestos-cement sheets on importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Yugo-Slavia and France.

Notice No. 60 of 1926, in so far as it relates to the imposition of an exchange dumping duty on cement on importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Yugo-Slavia.

Notice No. 40 of 1927, whereby an exchange dumping duty was imposed on cement on importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Poland.
