PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Entitled "The Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Fund
Further Amendment Proclamation, 1929."

Whereas it is desirable further to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Fund Proclamation No. 47 of 1919 as amended by the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Fund Amendment Proclamation 1923 and the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Fund Further Amendment Proclamation 1923, which Proclamations being read as one are hereinafter referred to as the principal law;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the principal law, there shall be paid to the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration yearly as from the first day of July 1929 by every adult male native residing on the Bamangwato Reserve and the Batawana Reserve in the Bechuanaland Protectorate a tax in the form of an addition to the hut tax payable by each native so resident at the rate of five shillings for every pound of hut tax instead of three shillings as therein provided.

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the principal Proclamation and shall be called the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Fund Further Amendment Proclamation 1929 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
