PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending the General Dealers' Licences (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation No. 48 of 1924 by defining the term "aggregate sales."

Whereas it is desirable to amend the General Dealers' Licences (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation No. 48 of 1924 (herein after referred to as "the principal law");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers vested in me I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law is hereby amended by the addition of the following definition of the words "aggregate sales":—

"Aggregate sales" shall be taken to mean all sales in the ordinary course of a general dealer's business, including sales of live stock.

2. This Proclamation may be read for all purposes as the General Dealers' Licences (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Further Amendment Proclamation, 1929, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
