PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Further amending the Purchase of Stock Proclamation
(Bechuanaland Protectorate) No. 43 of 1923.

Whereas it is desirable further to amend the Purchase of Stock Proclamation (Bechuanaland Protectorate) No. 43 of 1923 as amended by Proclamation No. 17 of 1926 (herein after referred to as the "principal law"):

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers vested in me I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. (1) Sub-section (1) of section *four* of the principal law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted therefor:—

(1) Every such licence shall be for the period of one quarter of the calendar year commencing on the first day of January, April, July, or October, as the case may be. Licences may be granted for one or more quarters, but so that all licences issued in any calendar year shall terminate on the 31st day of December of that year.

(2) Sub-section (3) of section *four* of the principal law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section is substituted therefor:—

(3) The amount payable for every licence, whether endorsed "including purchase for export" or "not including purchase for export," shall be five pounds per quarter.

(3) Sub-section (4) of section *four* of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of all words after "the additional sum of" and the substitution therefor of the words "two shillings and sixpence in respect of such alteration."

2. This Proclamation may be read for all purposes as the Purchase of Stock (Bechuanaland Protectorate), 1923, Further Amendment Proclamation, 1929, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
