

# BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner,  
Amending the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trade Returns  
Proclamation No. 18 of 1923.

Whereas it is desirable to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trade Returns Proclamation No. 18 of 1923 (hereinafter called "the principal Proclamation");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "from the 1st April in one year to the 31st March in the following year" and by the insertion in their place of the words "from the 1st January to the 31st December in each year."

2. Section *two* of the principal Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "15th day of April" and by the insertion in their place of the words "15th day of January in the following year."

3. The Schedule to the principal Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the second date "19...." wherever those figures appear and by the insertion of the word "Pigs" after the word "Donkeys" under the heading "Exports."

4. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the principal Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
