PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner.

Amending in certain respects the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Proclamation No. 76 of 1921 of the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is desirable to amend in certain respects the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Proclamation No. 76 of 1921 of the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *eleven* of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Proclamation No. 76 of 1921 is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

11. Where the High Commissioner is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the legislative authority of any British Possession or any territory under His Majesty's protection for the enforcement within such possession or territory of maintenance orders made by Courts in the Bechuanaland Protectorate the High Commissioner may by notice in the *Gazette* extend this Proclamation to such possession or territory and this Proclamation shall thereupon apply in respect of such possession or territory as though the references to England or Ireland were references to such possession or territory and the references to the Secretary of State for the Colonies were references to the Governor of such possession or territory.

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Proclamation 1921 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
