PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Amending further in certain respects the General Dealers' Licences (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation, 1924 (No. 48 of 1924).

Whereas it is expedient further to amend in certain respects the General Dealers' Licences (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation 1924 (No. 48 of 1924) hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the addition after the words "sale or exchange" of the following words "including the business of a butcher or baker, where such is carried on in the same premises."

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
