

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Amending in certain respects the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1925 (No. 17 of 1925).

Whereas it is desirable to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1925, hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section 11 of the said Proclamation is hereby amended by the addition of the following sub-section the said section being numbered as sub-section (1):—

(2) Any person found within the Territory in possession of any skin or portion of the skin or of meat or horns or portion of the horn of any large game who is unable to give satisfactory explanation of his being in possession thereof shall be deemed to have hunted in contravention of the provisions of this section the animal of which the skin or portion thereof or meat or horns or portion of the horn have been found in his possession unless and until the contrary is proved by the accused person.

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
