

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 10 OF 1930.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel Notice No. 63 of 1929, and, under the provisions of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1925 (No. 17 of 1925), to alter, until further notice, in respect of those parts of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, known as the Tuli Block, Ngwato, and Francistown Districts, the definition of large game as contained in the Third Schedule to Proclamation No. 17 of 1925, by the exclusion therefrom of wildebeeste; and further, under section *three* of the aforesaid Proclamation, and in respect of the districts aforementioned, temporarily and until further notice, to add wildebeeste to the list of small game as defined in the Fourth Schedule to Proclamation No. 17 of 1925. This notice to take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
