

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 103 OF 1930.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

ADDITIONAL CUSTOMS DUTIES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, by section *three* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation 1925 (No. 20 of 1925), as amended, the High Commissioner may by notice in the *Gazette* bring into operation any duty referred to as a suspended duty in the First Schedule to that Proclamation, and that His Excellency has been pleased to declare that there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid the undermentioned duties:

- (1) a suspended duty at the rate of fifteen per cent. *ad valorem* as set forth in item 223 (a) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as substituted by section *three* (1) of the Customs Tariff Amendment Proclamation, 1930 (No. 16 of 1930), on liquid disinfectants and disinfectant powders, in bulk, the active ingredients of which are derivatives of coal tar, when imported or taken out of bond;
- (2) a suspended duty at the rate of twenty per cent. *ad valorem* as set forth in item 160 (b) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as substituted by section *three* (1) of the Customs Tariff Amendment Proclamation, 1930 (No. 16 of 1930), on common bottles of glass of the beer and mineral water types when imported or taken out of bond;
- (3) a suspended duty at the rate of one shilling on each bentwood chair as set forth in item 269 (c) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as substituted by section *three* (1) of the Customs Tariff Amendment Proclamation, 1930 (No. 16 of 1930), when imported or taken out of bond;
- (4) a suspended duty at the rate of two shillings and sixpence per 100 lb. as set forth in item 32 (a) (i) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as substituted by section *three* (1) of the Customs Tariff Amendment Proclamation, 1930 (No. 16 of 1930), on full cream sweetened condensed milk when imported or taken out of bond.
