

**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 106 of 1930.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation of Cattle Amendment Proclamation (No. 3 of 1930), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend and add to the Regulations appearing under High Commissioner's Notice No. 11 of 1930 as hereunder set forth, and to fix the date of publication of this notice as the date on which the Regulations as hereby amended shall have force and take effect.

Regulation 1 is hereby amended by the insertion of the following words between the word "purpose" and the following word "and" where they occur in the said Regulation:—

"by the Resident Commissioner or, in the case of privately owned weighbridges, over weighbridges approved at the time of weighing by the Chief Veterinary Officer or other officer designated by the Resident Commissioner for the purpose".

Regulation 3 is hereby amended by the omission after the word "weighbridges" of the words "provided for that purpose" and the insertion in lieu thereof of the words "specified in Regulation 1 hereof".

Regulation 4 is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph at the end thereof:

"No weighing for export shall be allowed unless in accordance with such conditions as may be laid down by the Chief Veterinary Officer in regard thereto".

The following new regulation numbered 6 is added to the said Regulations:—

"6. Any person wishing to erect a cattle weighbridge for the purpose of export under Regulation 1 shall first make application to the Resident Commissioner and submit a design thereof and particulars of the name of the maker and the construction, and set forth the exact position and locality where it is proposed to erect the weighbridge and the Resident Commissioner shall in his discretion permit or prohibit the erection of such weighbridge, and, in the event of permission being granted, such weighbridge shall be subject to inspection and examination at any time by any Representative of the Administration."
