HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 34 of 1930.

Under and by virtue of the *second* section of the Foreign Letters of Administration Act, 1888, of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope, which is in force, *mutatis mutandis*, in the Bechuanaland Protectorate by virtue of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Proclamations Nos. 13 of 1897 and 36 of 1909, I do hereby notify that the legislature of Southern Rhodesia has made proper reciprocal provision for the recognition of Letters of Administration granted in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, and that from and after the publication in the *Gazette* of this notice the provisions of the said Act shall come into force with regard to all Letters of Administration granted in Southern Rhodesia.
