

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 78 OF 1930.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

ADDITIONAL CUSTOMS DUTIES ON WHEAT AND  
WHEAT GROUND OR OTHERWISE PREPARED.

It is hereby notified for general information that by section *three* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925 (Proclamation No. 20 of 1925), as amended, the High Commissioner may by notice in the *Gazette* bring into operation any duty referred to as a suspended duty in the First Schedule to that Proclamation, and that His Excellency has been pleased to declare that there shall be charged, levied, collected, and paid customs duties at the rates of sixpence per 100 lb. and eightpence per 100 lb. respectively, in addition to the ordinary duties set forth in items 15 (a) (i) and 15 (a) (ii) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, on—

(a) wheat, in the grain; and

(b) wheat, ground or otherwise prepared;

imported or taken out of bond.
