

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 96 of 1930.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

ADDITIONAL CUSTOMS DUTY ON SUGAR.

It is hereby notified for general information that, by section *three* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925 (No. 20 of 1925), as amended, the High Commissioner may by Notice in the *Gazette* bring into operation any duty referred to as a suspended duty in the First Schedule to that Proclamation, and that His Excellency has been pleased to declare that there shall be charged, levied, collected, and paid a suspended duty of three shillings and sixpence per 100 lb. on sugar as set forth in item 43 (c) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925 (No. 20 of 1925), as substituted by section *three* (1) of the Customs Tariff (Amendment) Proclamation, 1930 (No. 16 of 1930), when imported or taken out of bond.
